This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation nit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 01/07/09 at 1:08 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 8214 W Keefe Avenue for a Theft complaint. Officers spoke to the victim who stated an unknown person stole her wallet out of her purse as she sat at the bar. Officers did speak with the bartender who stated she was informed about the lost wallet. A report was filed.

2. On 03/20/2014 Milwaukee police were dispatched to an Aggravated Battery complaint at 3717 North 76th Street (Schneider's Food and Drink). Investigation revealed two female patrons became involved in an argument, culminating in one patron striking the other in the head with a glass mug. The victim sustained an injury requiring stitches. Milwaukee police incident report # 140790018 filed.

3. On 09/04/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a fight complaint at 3717 North 76th Street. Investigation revealed a patron of the business became loud and boisterous, threatening the bartender. The patron was cited.
-

4. On 01/31/2020 at 1:52am an officer observed several cars in the parking lot of Schneider's Tavern, 3717 N. 76th St. At 2:00am the officer observed 2 patrons exit the bar with open beer bottles. The officer had the subjects empty the bottles and at 2:04am entered the tavern and found approximately 15 patrons inside. The patrons left and the officer spoke with the bartender, who stated she was working alone and could not get the patrons to leave. The applicant arrived while the officers were on scene and was advised he would receive a warning and future violations would result in a citation.

5. On 05/18/23 at 1:47a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an DUI at 3717 N. 76th St. On arrival officers were advised they just missed the suspect. Security advised officers the subject was driving around the parking lot doing "donuts" and attempting to hit other vehicles. The staff were cooperative with the investigation.
6. On 06/11/23 at 10:16a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an Armed Robbery at 3717 N. 76th St. Investigation revealed this had nothing to do with the license premise other than occurring in their parking lot. The employees were cooperative with the officers and provided video surveillance to assist with the investigation.
7. On 08/02/23 at 12:00a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 3717 N. 76th St. Officers were met by the victim who stated they were hit inside the bar and lost consciousness and was assisted by security guards. The manager on scene stated they did not observe the altercation. Video surveillance was not observed as the employees did not know how to access it and the camera room was locked.
8. On 08/21/23 at 1:01a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery DV at 3717 N. 76th St. The officers interviewed the victim in the parking lot, who stated they have a Protection Order on a subject, who showed up at the bar and punched the victim multiple times. The bar was already closing for the night; therefore, the officer did not have an opportunity to speak to the manager or observe video surveillance of the incident.
9. On 10/03/23 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 3717 N. 76th St. Upon arrival officers were informed by bar staff that an altercation occurred at the location and one of the subjects was brought to Froedtert Hospital. Officers went to the hospital and spoke with the victim who stated that the suspect intentionally and without consent bit the tip of his left pinky off. Officers then followed up back at the location 3717 N. 76th St. Officers spoke with bar staff who stated that the victim and the suspect got into an argument. The victim then pushed the suspect during the argument and the suspect bit the pinky finger of the victim. The suspect actually ended biting the tip of the pinky finger off and fled the location. One of the bar staff gave the victim a cup off ice and he left with the fingertip to the hospital. Officers obtained video footage from the business.
10. On 11/10/23 at 10:28pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 3717 N. 76th St. Upon arrival officers observed the victim lying face down, and observed that her face was swollen around the mouth jaw area. Two subjects on scene who refused to give officers their names stated that the security guard threw the victim down stairs and punched the victim in the face. The victim was transported to the hospital for medical attention. Officers spoke with the victim at the hospital regarding the incident. The victim stated that three female subjects punched, kicked and stomped on her in front of Schneider's Bar.

On 11/11/23 at 9:39pm, Milwaukee Police conducted follow up at 3717 N. 76th St., regarding the battery. Officers spoke with the security guard, who stated that the victim arrived at the location last night intoxicated. The victim then got into a physical altercation with others at the bar. The security guard stated that he then broke up the fight and escorted the victim out of the establishment. The security guard stated that he does not know how she was injured and he did not strike or push her down stairs. Officers attempted to meet the victim also during the follow up but she stated that she was not feeling well. The victim did state to officers that she does want to pursue charges.

On 11/19/23, Milwaukee Police conducted follow up at 3717 N. 76th St., regarding potential video of the battery that occurred 11/10/23. The staff on scene stated that the owner would be at the business tomorrow and he could assist on the video regarding the incident. Officers also obtained a signed consent disclosure for the release of the victim's documented injuries from the hospital.

Officers stated that further follow up will be conducted regarding the video footage of the incident.

11. On 04/14/24 at 2:33a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 3717 N 76th St. Investigation revealed there was no battery and this was an argument between subjects in the parking lot. There is video surveillance, however, it does not record and is live only. The business was cooperative.

12. On 10/27/24 at 12:50a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 3717 N. 76th St. No violations were found.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

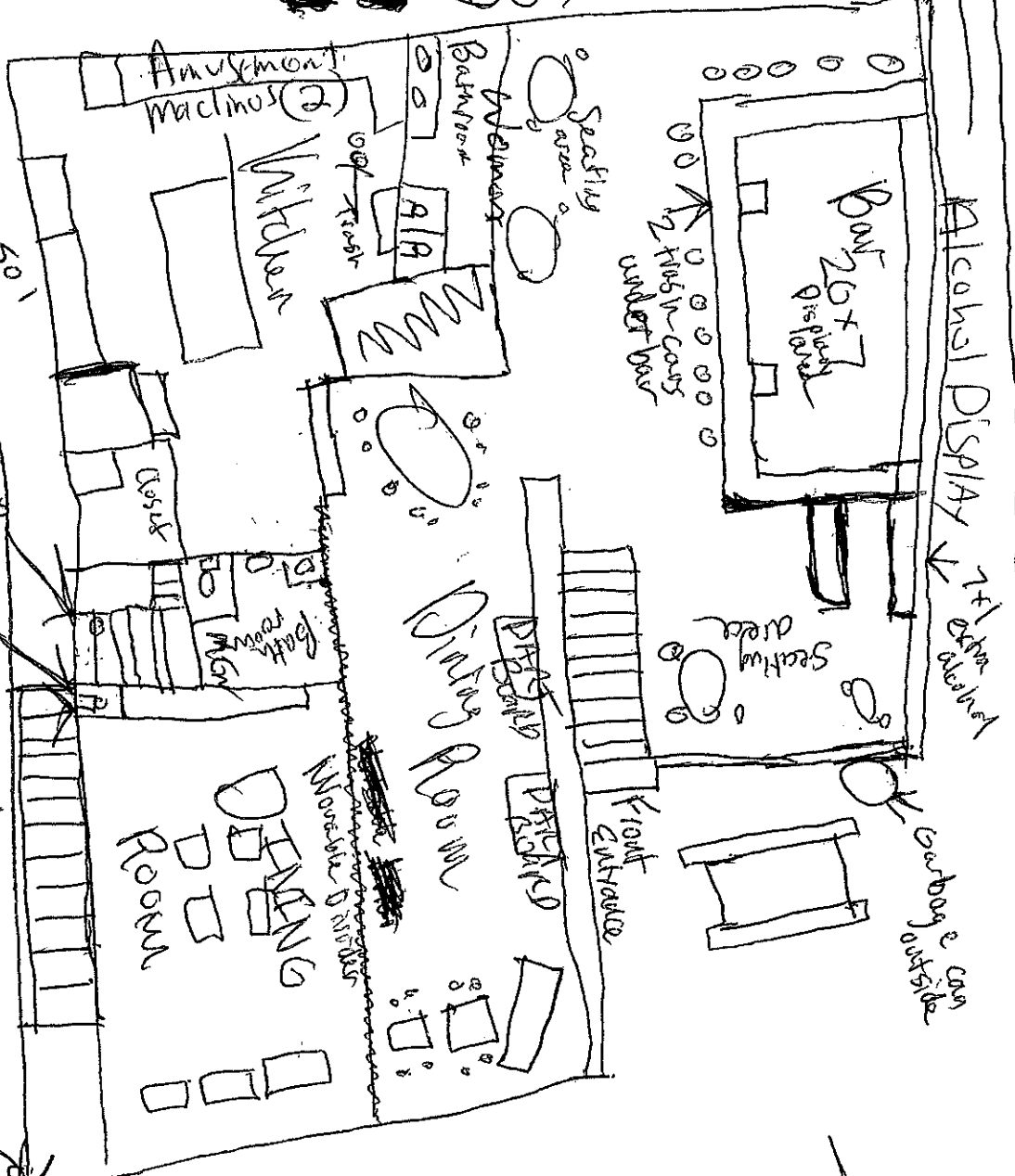

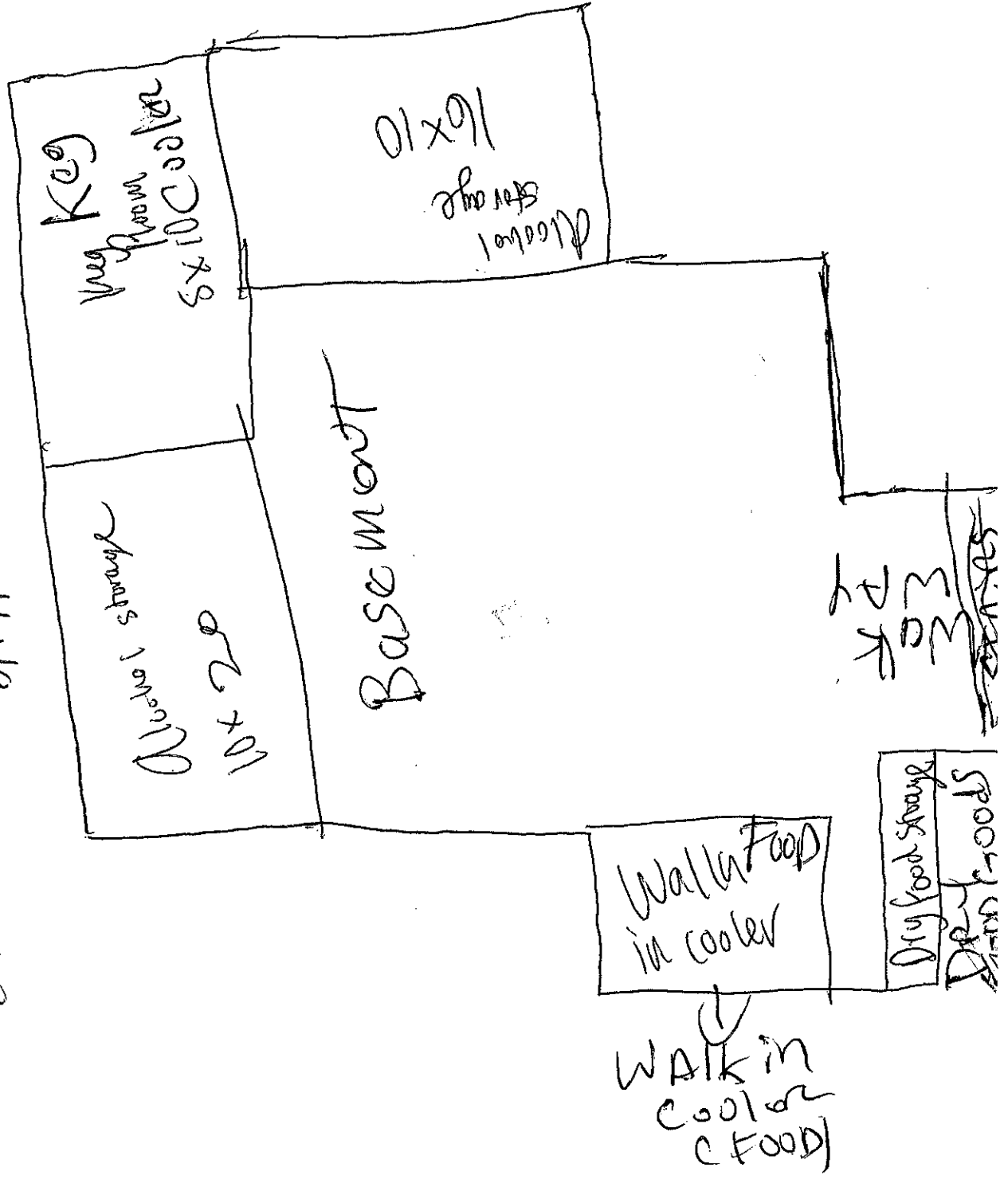
