This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 05/19/18 a 17 year old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police Department and WI WINS Tobacco initiative, was able to purchase a 2 pack of Swisher Sweet Cigars at 6001C N. Teutonia Avenue, The sales clerk admitted to selling the item and the station was mailed a MARTS enrollment packet.
2. On 04/28/19 at 10:01pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6001C N. Teutonia Avenue for a trouble with juvenile complaint. Upon arrival officers interviewed the caller/employee, who was very cooperative, who stated that 3 juveniles entered the station and created a disturbance. Security got involved with the disturbance and the juveniles left. Police found the juveniles, gave them a verbal warning, and told them not to return to the filling station.
3. On 01/30/20 at 11:05pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6001C N. Teutonia Avenue for a subject with weapon complaint. Investigation revealed that a domestic violence incident occurred at the filling station and the suspect was armed with a hammer. The suspect did break out a door window in an attempt to go after the victim who had locked himself inside the establishment. The victim was ultimately able to "bear hug" the suspect and help police disarm the subject. The employee was cooperative during the investigation.

4. On 03/12/20 at 9:00pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6001 N. Teutonia Avenue for a shots fired complaint. Upon arrival, the officers interviewed the caller/employee who stated that he heard multiple gunshots coming from the area of the gas pumps. Surveillance footage showed a subject fire approximately 6 shots by the gas pumps, enter a vehicle, and flee the location.
5. On 08/17/20 at 4:38pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6001 N. Teutonia Avenue for a shoplifter complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject took property from the filling station without paying for it. The employee did not want a citation issued but wanted the subject to leave the premise. The employee was fully cooperative with the investigation and all permits to the business were on display.

Teutonia Ave. Officers were advised a subject was inside the store making inappropriate comments and lingering around. The subject left when they observed the police on scene. On Tuesday April 2, 2024, while in full in full duty uniform equipped with an axon body camera activated and in a marked squad my partner PO Eugene REESE and I were dispatched to a trouble with subject call that occurred at 6001 N Teutonia Av which is located in the City and Count of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin.

CAD INFORMATION: CLLR STS SUBJ WONT LEAVE LOC, CLLR STS SUBJ CAUSES PROBLEMS EVERY TIME SHE COMES INTO THE GAS STATION. NFI.

Upon arrival we observed a black female who was wearing a Light blue hooded sweatshirt, Black pants and purple shoes, which matched the caller's description of the subject, exit the business and walked Westbound on Florist Av. Officers spoke with the security guard who was verbally identified as Chris L. DAVIS (B/M 08/19/1965) who stated that there have been many incidents involving the same individual, but no reports involving her have been filed.

Officers entered the business and talked with the clerk who was verbally as Wali SYED (W/M 04/29/1992) who stated the same thing as DAVIS. That there have been multiple incidents involving the individual but that no reports have been filed. Officers instructed SYED to contact police if she was to come back tonight.

While on scene, we observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. During our investigation I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

On Wednesday May 1st, 2024, at approximately 22:53 while assigned to squad 4281, PO Jason DAERING and I were dispatched to an "Armed Robbery, Carjacking" at the location of 6001 N Teutonia Av., which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

Investigation:

Upon our arrival, PO DAERING and I were met by the caller/ victim outside the Citgo gas station (Silver Mills Gas & Food) located at 6001 N Teutonia Av. The caller/ victim would verbally identify himself as Levelle A. WILLIAMS (b/m, 04/05/05). WILLIAMS advised PO DAERING and I that he was robbed by gunpoint by 4 black males wearing all black clothing in which those individuals took his vehicle keys along with his vehicle described as a black 2013 Chevrolet Malibu, bearing WI plate AVT-7161, his necklace which he described as being white silver with a picture of his grandparents for medallion, along with his credit cards, and drivers identification card that he

stated he had left inside the vehicle prior to the vehicle being taken. WILLIAMS stated that all 4 subjects entered his vehicle and fled northbound onto N Teutonia Av.

PO DAERING would contact district 4's shift commander Lt. ELSER to advise him of the incident. Lt. ELSER would advise PO DAERING and I that CIB would respond to take over investigating.

While waiting on scene, I spoke with one of the employees of the Citgo gas station who identified himself as Paramjit S SINGH (b/m, 09/17/88). I asked SINGH if I would be able to review video surveillance which may have captured the incident on video, SINGH advised me that he did not have access to the video system and that owner would be in at 10:00AM the next morning. I would later advise SINGH that officers needed to review the video to help develop suspects regarding the incident, SINGH stated that he would work on accessing the video while we continued to investigate the incident. SINGH would eventually flag PO DAERING and I down stating he had access to the video in which I was able to obtain/ review. The video would then be recovered and placed on evidence.com.

I would later interview SINGH regarding what he had observed prior to the robbery happening in which SINGH stated the following.

SINGH stated that while working behind the counter, he and another coworker observed four individuals congregating near the outside entrance to the store which appeared to be suspicious to him. SINGH stated that some of the subjects entered the store and asked for a mask. SINGH stated that when all four subjects were outside he observed the victim walking out to his vehicle from within the store in which he observed the four subjects rob the victim by gunpoint for his vehicle. SINGH stated that he and his coworker both watched the incident on their camera system which is behind the counter while the robbery was occurring. SINGH stated that after the robbery the victim came inside in which he asked the victim if he was robbed at which point the victim stated he was. SINGH had no further information regarding the incident.

End of interview.

Squad 9263 Detective YOUNG would respond to take over the investigating the incident/ Detective YOUNG advised PO DAERING and I to write a supplemental report regarding the incident.

It should be noted that during my investigation I observed no violation in the licenses premise.

This concludes my report.

On Saturday, May 25th, 2024 at approximately 1:56 AM while in Full Duty Uniform equipped with an Axon Body activated and in a marked squad, I was dispatched with my partner P.O. Eugene REESE along with Squad 4332 P.O. John MUELLER and P.O. HARRINGTON, Squad 4390 P.O. Jason ORTIZ, and Squad 4340 P.O. Adam GAMROTH and P.O. Jose DE LA VEGA to 6001 N Teutonia Av located in the City and County of Milwaukee to investigate an Subject With a Weapon Complaint.

Upon arrival, I observed the location to be a Citgo Gas Station. The call was originally for a Subject With a Weapon, but upon arrival to the Citgo Gas Station, I P.O. NEAL observed the victim waiving officers down who was later identified as Xavier J. CARTER (B/M 01/29/1991) who stated that he was just robbed of his belonging minutes prior to our arrival. CARTER stated that on today's date, Saturday 25th, 2024, at approximately 2:00 am, he exited his vehicle to enter the gas station to purchase a Black and Mild. CARTER stated that his vehicle was parked in front of Gas Pump #1, stating that he intended to be "in and out" of the Gas Station. CARTER stated as he exited his vehicle which was a White Chrysler Pacific bearing a Indiana Registration Plate of FL293ACP, VIN: 2C4RC1L74NR173773 an Unknown Actor who he described as a Black Male, approximately 17-18 years old, approximately 5'10"-5'11", approximately 130-140lbs, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with a white left sleeve and a red right sleeve, black pants, a black satchel, wearing black "covid style" mask and armed with Black Handgun with an Extended Clip was walking towards him with another person who he identified as a Black Female, approximately 17-18 years old, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, black shorts, with short "bob styled" hair.

Squad 4332 P.O. MUELLER and P.O. HARRINGTON spoke with the security guard on scene who was identified as Christopher L. DAVIS (M/B, 08/19/1965, ph #414-419-7537). Officers were able to observe video from the armed robbery that occurred on 05/25/2024 at approximately 01:49 AM at the listed location. The incident occurred on the exterior of the gas station at the Southwest corner of the parking lot, nearest to pump #1. DAVIS stated that he initiated the call for service due to observing two black males enter the Gas Station with Black Handguns that were visible in their waistbands. DAVIS states there were 5 black males, 3 black females in hooded sweatshirts and masks outside of the listed location. DAVIS stated that the subjects initially left the gas station then returned moments later.

I spoke to licensed premise employee who was identified as SAM (A/M 10/07/1998) who stated that he did not observe the incident that took place outside of the listed locations, but did state that he observed the 8 subjects inside of the Gas Station who continued to walk in and out of the location. The business was *cooperative* with the investigation. The business had 1 security officer on scene. They were *unarmed*.

I reviewed video surveillance footage. On the camera footage, I observed this incident occurred on today's date, May 25th, 2024 at approximately 1:49 AM. I observed the two unknown actors approach CARTER, snatching his Cartier glasses from his face and observed CARTER fleeing back towards the Gas Station entry door in fear that the dangerous weapon would be used against him. . The video was not recovered on scene. Officers informed SAM to reach out to the store owner regarding uploading the video footage to evidence.com due to SAM not being able to upload or download the footage on scene and not having the capabilities to. I, P.O. NEAL provided an email to SAM and informed him to reach out when the store owner is able to obtain and download the video footage of this incident. Both SAM and DAVIS were able to assist with camera footage.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. During my investigation for Subject With a Weapon I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.
