STAFF COMMENTS The National Historic Lighthouse Preservation Act

of 2000 provides a mechanism for the disposal of federally-owned historic light stations. As part of the process, the light stations are being evaluated for National Register eligibility. The Milwaukee Breakwater Light is determined potentially eligible for National Register listing. As a Certified Local Government, Milwaukee's HPC is required to either support or not support the nomination and forward their decision to the United States Coast Guard. The building is a unique structure and has been a

visual landmark on the lakefront since its

construction in 1926. It has had very few changes

to either its interior or exterior.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION Recommend that HPC support the nomination.
