Subject: Revised State/Municipal Agreement

Highway Safety Improvement Program West Kilbourn Avenue and North 6th Street

Dear Council Members:

The City of Milwaukee has requested an increase in preliminary engineering design funding for the subject project and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) has transmitted the attached revised State/Municipal Agreement to be executed by the City of Milwaukee for programming and construction of geometric traffic signal improvements at the subject intersection.

The increase in preliminary engineering design funding is necessary to satisfy revised Federal reporting and documentation requirements associated with the project. The total estimated preliminary engineering design cost increase of the project is \$27,000, with a grantor share increase of \$24,300 and a City share increase of \$2,700.

We have prepared and recommend adoption of the attached resolution authorizing the Commissioner of Public Works and the City Comptroller to execute a revised State/Municipal Agreement for the project. The resolution also directs the City Comptroller to transfer funds to the project sub-account for the City's share of preliminary engineering costs.
