Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 100449

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 100449, being a resolution to amend a special privilege for change of ownership to Wells Fargo Bank N.A. for encroachment into the public right-of-way of electrical wiring, electrical outlets, moveable planters, tree grates and covered walk and for addition of a moveable planter and two bollards for the premises at 250 East Wisconsin Avenue.

Previous special privilege grantees had requested permission to keep and maintain electrical wiring, electrical outlets, moveable planters, tree grates and a covered walk in the public right-of-way adjacent to the subject premises. Permission for said items was granted under either Common Council Resolution File Number 040825 or Common Council Resolution File Number 050019. A site visit revealed the presence of two bollards in the west sidewalk area of North Broadway and an additional moveable planter in the north sidewalk area of East Wisconsin Avenue.

We are not aware that the presence of said items has had or will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will amend the name of the grantee and allow said bollards and additional moveable planter to continue to occupy the public right-of-way.
