Dear Ms. Nuell and Atty. Whitcomb:

This is to notify you that on Wednesday, September 7, 2011, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that the Class "B" Tavern and Record Spin licenses for the premises at 4001 W. Fond Du Lac Ave. ("All Star Sports Bar") be renewed with a forty-five (45) day suspension based upon a neighbor objection and the police report.

On September 9, 2011, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the renewal applications for the Class "B" Tavern and Record Spin licenses in which the Committee recommended that the licenses be renewed with a forty-five (45) day suspension based upon a neighbor objection and the police report. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, September 20, 2011 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Licenses Committee to renew the Class "B" Tavern and Record Spin licenses with a forty-five (45) day suspension based upon a neighbor objection and the police report.

Said suspension is to be in effect from 12:01 a.m., October 23, 2011 through midnight, December 6, 2011.
