Dear Alderman Murphy and Finance Committee Members:

The Department of Employee Relations (DER) recommends approval of the attached file as a technical clarification regarding retiree health insurance for City employees who had been members of the Association of Law Enforcement Allied Services Personnel (ALEASP) prior to the contract termination. File #070011 treats them the same as active Management employees rather than treating them the same as active non-management non-represented and other general City employees.

As retirees, management employees will pay the same as active management employees in 2011 and after January 1, 2012. As retirees non-management and non-represented employees as well as other general City employees will have an opportunity to go through regular retirement in 2011 and have a fixed premium until they turn 65. The intent was to treat former ALEASP employees the same as non-management non-represented and other general City employees, not the same as management employees.
