

- Copper, fiber cables
- Call boxes
- Phone system
- Network hardware
- Leasing of Conduit \$725,000 in 2011

## Capital Program Funding Elements

- Copper cable small projects for remote facility connections
- Fiber optic cable –
   1) extend network: Housing Authority, libraries, remaining City buildings
  - 2) network redundancies: critical facilities
- Phone hardware upgrade, maintain phone system
- Network hardware upgrade, maintain core networks

- Phone System Upgrade 2012
- Fiber Optic Cables to Water Booster
   Facilities 2012
- Diverse path restoration and creation for bridge repairs and Zoo Interchange construction – 2012 and 2013

### Previous Questions - Copper Cable


#### Copper migration strategy

- fiber optic cable provides more reliable service, higher bandwidth capacities, and lower overall maintenance costs
- existing copper cabling can cost-effectively serve the needs of low-bandwidth, remote sites
- For new systems, use of copper beyond the nearest City network presence will not be allowed, unless exceptional circumstances require it
- For existing systems, they are to be migrated to fiber or copper to the nearest City network presence as the systems are upgraded or replaced

### Previous Questions - Copper Cable

- Cable Maintenance
  - \$380,000 in 2010
  - \$310,000 in 2011

# Previous Questions – DOT Resource Sharing

- Original agreement in March of 2005, updating in 2012
  - Connect to DOT at I-43 at Locust St
  - Connect to DOT at Greenfield Ave
  - Connect to DOT Operations Center
  - Connect to DOT at Port of Milwaukee
  - Utilize DOT to serve Miller Park

# Previous Questions – DOT Resource Sharing

- As part of Zoo Interchange construction:
  - Establishing connection at I-94 and 84<sup>th</sup> St
  - Establishing connection at I-894 and Beloit Rd
  - Providing conduit to DOT at I-94 and Hawley Rd
- DOT traffic cameras utilized by DPW and MPD
- DOT road sensors utilized by DPW

### Previous Questions – Outsourcing

- Previous studies in 1989 and 1996
  - 1989 recommended City-maintained network and fiber-optic backbone
  - 1996 implemented recommendations to lease conduit space and resource-sharing with local organizations
- Maintaining our own facilities provides flexibility, responsiveness, and seamless design
