111504 A substitute charter ordinance relating to the selection of a retirement option in the employees retirement system.

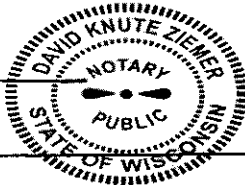
