Dear Alderman:

You had asked that I follow up with you regarding my testimony last week at the Steering and Rules Committee hearing regarding water fluoridation. I had stated that Albuquerque had indeed stopped adding fluoride to the water and it was presented as such by Alderman Bohl. I had discussed the fact that their water was still fluoridated naturally at a level of 0.7ppm. You requested I share that documentation with you and as discussed, I've attached a report from the Chair of the Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority.

You'll note in the chart on page 6 there is a table the shows the minimum and average amount of natural fluoride that has been detected in the systems and it is 0.5ppm and 0.7ppm respectively. On the top of page 9 there is also discussion around this issue and the new HHS /CDC recommended levels.
