NIDC Resources



- Common Council allocated \$200,000 to NIDC for implementation of the Healthy
 Neighborhoods Initiative and Community
 Improvement Projects during 2012.
 - \$40,000 supported projects in the participating Healthy Neighborhoods
 - \$110,000 supported Community Improvement Projects in neighborhoods citywide
 - \$50,000 allocated to a Block Stabilization Program
- NIDC has partnered with the Greater Milwaukee Foundation for six years and in 2012 GMF committed \$400,000 in resources to nine "Healthy Neighborhoods."






