### City of Milwaukee Historic Designation Application Instructions Site or Structure

To be considered for designation by the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission, it is necessary for an applicant to complete the enclosed application form and return it. The application is designed so that it can be completed without professional assistance. Although most of the items are self-explanatory, some may be unfamiliar to you. The following instructions explain the most frequently misunderstood items. If y ou have further questions, do not hesitate to contact the Historic Preservation Commission staff at (414) 286-5722.

1. **Historic Name:** This is ordinarily the first name given to the building or the name of the original owner. A name associated with a site at a later date may also be used if it can be demonstrated to have more historic validity than the name by which it was first known.

Common Name: This is usually the name by which a site is currently popularly identified. It may be the same as the historic name.

- **Representation in Existing Surveys**: If you know whether or not your property has been included in the City of Milwaukee Historic Building Inventory or some other inventory or has been previously historically designated by either the former Milwaukee Landmarks Commission or the National Register of Historic Places, please indicate this information. If you do not know, just write "unknown."
- **DESCRIPTION** Written Description: Describe the structure's shape, building materials, and exterior features in paragraph form. Specify types and colors of materials, the design or pattern of decorative ornament, and the arrangement of architectural elements. Also describe other features on the site such as outbuildings, decorative fences, sculpture, fountains, or landscape treatments that may add to the significance or historic character of the site. Briefly describe additions or alterations and non -historic features. Use continuation sheets, if necessary.
- 7. <u>SIGNIFICANCE</u> Written Statement of Significance: In a brief opening paragraph, enumerate the areas of significance previously checked and explain specifically why the site is important in each of these categories. In subsequent paragraphs, and on continuation sheets, if necessary, detail the history of the site and the people or events that have contributed to its significance. You may want to attach photocopies of documentation to support and further amplify your research.
- **8. Major Bibliographical References:** Include major references. Use continuation sheets if necessary. Be sure to include publisher, city, and publication dates for books and edition dates for newspapers and periodicals.
- **Property Description:** Indicate the acreage of the nominated property (if less than one acre, just say "less than on acre") and the legal property description form the deed or tax assessor's records.

### HOLY MT. CARMEL MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH \*1989 HISTORY\*

Eight years ago on February 28, 1981, fourteen people attended a meeting that was called by Reverend, Betty S. Hayes. The meeting was held at 3600 West Marion Street. The business discussed was plans for starting a new church. The plans and ideas expressed at this meeting became a reality on Tuesday, March 3, 1981. On that day twenty-six jubilant persons gathered at the New Hope Missionary Baptist Church to witness the organizing of our new church. Pastor R. L. Lathan served as moderator and the Mt. Carmel Holy Missionary Baptist Church was formed!! The name of Holy Mt. Carmel Missionary Baptist Church was later chosen because of the confusion our previous name caused with the Mt. Carmel Missionary Baptist Church here in the city.

With great anticipation we marched into the upcoming week and on Sunday, March 3, 1981, just five days after our organization, we held our very first worship service in a basement located at 3600 West Marion Street. Our Sunday School started at 9:30am and the morning worship followed at 11:00am. The fact that we were in a basement didn't "move" us-we were just happy yo be there. Our choir sang "Sign Me Up For The Christian Jubilee" and "I Know He Can, I Believe He Will" with such power that the Holy Ghost was soon in our midst. Under God's anointing Pastor Hayes spoke to us in her message and said "Let's Go To The Mountain Top"!! Twenty-five new members joined on that Sunday morning. We were sitting on borrowed chairs that first Sunday, but before the week was gone, the Lord had blessed us to be able to purchase \$700.00 worth of chairs of our own--- What A Mighty God We Serve!! Two more members joined our family on Tuesday, March 10, 1981, during our first Bible Class.

At this point our faith was beginning to increase but Pastor Hayes continued to encourage and feed our souls. Her sermons for the next few Sundays were:

"Are You able To Pay What It Costs?"

"Let The Lord Fix It"

"Use What We Have"

And on Sunday, April 5, 1981, she reminded us that "He Done What He Said He Would Do". This was the Sunday that we formed a car processional and left the basement at 36th and Marion and journeyed to our new home at 1122 West North Avenue!! During the year of 1981, God blessed us with six ordained deacons. 1 licensed minister and a total of 119 members join in 1981. We received our first out-of-town invitation to Corinthians M.B. Church in Chicago, II.

With the arrival of each new year, the blessings of God continued to prevail. Some of the blessings are as follows:

### 1982

- Purchased our first church van

- Aired our first radio broadcast over Radio Station WYLO

- Received 1 more licensed minister

- A total of 76 new member joined in 1982

### 1983

- Received yet another licensed minister
- A total of 62 new member joined.

- Received five powerful and Holy Ghost filled missionaries

- A total of 29 new members joined

### 1985

- Received two more inspiring missionaries

- Received one more licensed minister

- Holy Mt. Carmel became a part of the American Baptist Convention

- A total of 27 new members joined

At this time we had been running for Jesus for five years, and we didn't feel "no ways tired."

### 1986

- Our first Ask-A-Thon Drive was started

The Gospel Outreach Hayes Evangelistic Crusade was founded, which is one of Holy Mt. Carmel's greatest ministries and has blessed many people in the city of Milwaukee, the State of Wisconsin and many other states across the country.

- A total of 44 new member joined in 1986

Nineteen eighty-seven proved to be a wonderful year for Holy Mt. Carmel. From all of our teaching we had learned that "a people without a vision would perish". We had a vision—and that vision was to build a church from the ground. During that year God, with his almighty power, opened the door to make our vision become a reality. He blessed in such a unique way that we were able to purchase approximately three acres of land. We also began our jail-house ministry at the Ethan Allen Boys Home in Wales, WI.

In 1988 we were blessed to have a broadcast ministry over Radio Station WYLO for a brief period of time, the Hayes Evangelistic Love Choir was borne, we received two more ordained deacons, an additional Radio Minstry was added on Radio Station KKOL in Hampton, Arkansas, on August 19, 1988 we held our "Ground Breaking" Ceremony and in December of 1988, we obtained our building permit from the City of Milwaukee, which gave us permission to start construction of our new building!! Oh Hallelujah and Praise God!!!

This is the middle of 1989, and God has done :Great things for us - whereof we are GLAD!! The vision of erecting a new edifice from God's beautiful ground is HERE!!! Thursday, May 25, 1989, 12:00 noon, was declared a day of rejoicing and celebration by the members of Holy Mt. Carmel — for on that blessed day the construction workers pulled their trucks ont our land at 2127 West Garfield Avenue and began digging the hole on which the foundation of our new building will be laid. "OH WHAT A HAPPY DAY!!!

Since that first meeting eight years ago, we can look back and say "Look where He brought us from". A total of 19 new members have joined Hely Mt. Carmel since January. Approximately 490 members have been a part of our family and of that number only three active members, one infant and three-others have been funeralized. Truly God has smiled or us!! And during those years 20 happy couples have been joined in holy matrimony. approximately 75 people have been baptized.

We the members of Holy Mt. Carmel thank God for all of his blessings. We thank Him most of all for giving us the greatest, most powerful and loving leader in the world, our own Pastor, Rev. Betty S. Hayes. For without a good leader and God's guidance, we would not be where we are today. We thank God, who has given us the VICTORY through Jesus Christ our Lord!!!
