TEXT OF AMENDMENT

I move to substitute Substitute 1 of File Number 121137 with Proposed Substitute A.

ANALYSIS OF AMENDMENT

Proposed Substitute A clarifies that the reporting requirements applies to Class "A" and Class "B" licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquor, not all Class "A" and Class "B" licenses. Also, Proposed Substitute A provides that no Class "A" or Class "B" license for the sale of intoxicating liquor may be issued for premises the main entrance of which is less than 300 feet from the main entrance of any day care center (similar to existing prohibitions for Class "A" and Class "B" licenses within 300 feet of churches, schools and hospitals).
