Proposal	Per HPC staff recommendation, remove individual designation from the building which was condemned and completely razed following two disastrous fires.	
Staff comments	The preservation ordinance now allows for the de-listing of individually-designated buildings that have been completely destroyed by fires and natural catastrophes such as the former Pabst Tavern, also known as Metropolitan Hall which was completely destroyed by fires in 2006. The lot is vacant today and the designation serves no purpose at present or for future redevelopment. If approved by the HPC, the proposal will proceed to the Zoning and Neighborhood Development Committee for recommendation to the full Milwaukee Common Council which in turn will vote on the de-listing.
