Dear Ms. Bingham:

We have received your claim for the amount of \$1,002.44 in relation to the property damage you sustained on January 2, 2013 at 2807 North 50th Street in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Our investigation reveals that on January 2, 2013 the Milwaukee Police Department went to your residence in response to a felony warrant issued by the probation/parole officer assigned to Frank Arms. A check of his electronic monitoring device placed him outside of the residence located at 2807 North 50th Street during a time frame that he was required to be inside the residence. Once the police arrived, they attempted to gain entry by calling, knocking and ringing the door bell. Because there was no response from Mr. Arms, the police were required to force entry into the residence. The Felon in Violation of Probation warrant was issued by the probation officer assigned to Frank Arms. To obtain a copy of the warrant, please contact Daniel Isaacson at (414)-232-3341.

The Milwaukee Police Department exercised the appropriate action in this forced entry and as such the City of Milwaukee would not be liable. Therefore, we are denying your claim.
