
Dear Ms. Mejta-Mortimer:

We have received your claim in the amount of \$39.05, relating to damage allegedly sustained to your garage light on January 18, 2013 when a sanitation crew was collecting garbage at your residence located at 3807 North 78th Street.

Our investigation reveals that the Sanitation Section report completed as a result of this alleged incident notes that there is no conclusive evidence that the City caused the damage. In addition, the Sanitation Supervisor notes that the garbage crew denies damaging your garage light. As such, the City cannot accept liability. Therefore, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
