Factors which Influence Infant Mortality

Accidents and Demographics: homicides older than 35, Secondor younger Poverty, hand smoke chronic stress, than 17 exposure discrimination, domestic violence, lack of social Tummy support, unemployment, low educational sleeping or attainment over-heating Other Unsafe sleep environment: bed-sharing, sofas, chairs, car SIDS & seats, pillows, bumper pads Infections, under/overweight, late or no Accidental prenatal care, poor care, chronic disease, Suffocation e.g., high blood pressure, and diabetes Prematurity Congenital Genetic **Anomalies** predisposition Previous preterm birth, short interval between pregnancies, short cervix or other physical anomalies **Environmental** Mental triggers health, Complex tobacco, & unknown AODA, exposure factors to pollutants
