**TEXT OF AMENDMENT**

I move to amend Attachment B of the HOME 2013 additional Entitlement Recommendations by:

1. Reducing the recommended funding for the request titled "Social Development Commission – Housing – Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP)" by \$30,000, from \$30,000 to \$0.
2. Increasing the recommended funding for the request titled "Community First, Inc. – Housing – Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP)" by \$6,000, from \$50,000 to \$56,000.
3. Increasing the recommended funding for the request titled "Dominican Center for Women, Inc. – Housing – Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP)" by \$6,000, from \$25,000 to \$31,000.
4. Increasing the recommended funding for the request titled "Gibraltar Development of Milwaukee Corp. – Housing – Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP)" by \$6,000, from \$25,000 to \$31,000.
5. Increasing the recommended funding for the request titled "Housing Resources, Inc. – Housing – Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP)" by \$6,000, from \$25,000 to \$31,000.
6. Increasing the recommended funding for the request titled "Sherman Park Community Association – Housing – Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP)" by \$6,000, from \$25,000 to \$31,000.

## **ANALYSIS OF AMENDMENT**

This amendment to Attachment B of the HOME 2013 additional Entitlement Recommendations amends the Community Development Grants Administration recommendations by eliminating the \$30,000 in funding recommended for the Social Development Commission under the activity Housing-Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP) and increases by \$6,000 the funding recommendation to each of the 5 other providers under the same program for the same activity.
