In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

All work will be done according to photos and specifications contained in this COA. Although not a requirement, the use of naturally decay resistant woods such as Western Red Cedar or domestic Spanish Cedar are highly recommended. The use of western white pine or Ponderosa pine is "use at your risk" because this wood has been shown to decay rapidly in an exterior setting, often in as little as three years. All wood must be painted upon completion. New, bare wood that is left exposed to the exterior elements, often for as little as a week or two, will not hold paint as well or as long as wood that is immediately painted.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
