A substitute ordinance relating to the First Amendment to a Detailed Planned Development, for hotel development, on land-located on the east side of South Howell Avenue, north of West College Avenue, in the 13th Aldermanic District.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee ("Common Council"), do ordain as follows:
Part 1. There is added to the

Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Code") a new section to read as follows:

Section 295-907(2)(c).0197.

(DPD).

(3) The requirements set forth in said detailed plan attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A, constitute the zoning regulations for the area contained in such planned development district de this ordinance; or who shall build contrary to the plans or specifications submitted to and approved by the Commissioner of the Department of City Development, or any person firm or any person, firm, company or corporation who shall omit, neglect or refuse to do any act required in this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 200-19 of the Code.

Part 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions. The Common Council declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause. phrase or portion irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections. subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases or other portions declared void or invalid.
