### AMENDMENT INTENT

Increase Parking Fund Transfer to the General Fund by \$175,000. Reinstate \$175,000 payment to BMO Harris Bradley Center as provided in the Mayor's 2014 Proposed Budget and eliminated under Amendment 33A.

#### BACKGROUND

- 1. Passage of this amendment effectively reinstates a \$175,000 payment to the BMO Harris Bradley Center ("the Center") which was provided for in the Mayor's 2014 Proposed Budget, but eliminated under Amendment 33A.
- 2. The rationale provided for the payment to the Center has been for the fulfillment of a promise made by the Mayor to contribute non-tax levy funds to the Center's Maintenance and Facilities Fund, or for a fee for services rendered to coordinate events at the Center to maximize parking revenues at the City's 4<sup>th</sup> & Highland parking garage adjacent to the Center.
  - 3. The Parking Fund transferred \$18,550,000 to the General Fund in 2013 and projects to transfer \$17,250,000 in 2014.
  - **4.** Although the 2013 and 2014 transfers exceed the Parking Fund's "earnings" from operations and reduce cash reserves, projected cash reserves for 2014YE suggest the Parking Fund will remain liquid with a projected current ratio of 3.6.

### DISCUSSION

- 1. Passage of this amendment effectively reinstates a \$175,000 fee for the BMO-Harris Bradley Center which was eliminated by Amendment 33A.
- 2. An increase of \$175,000 in the Parking Fund's transfer to the General Fund in 2014 is not expected to materially affect the Parking Fund's operating liquidity.

## **EFFECT**

The budget effect of this amendment is an increase of \$175,000.

The tax-levy effect of this amendment is an increase of \$175,000.

If \$175,000 in increased revenues is recognized by the Comptroller, this amendment will reduce the tax levy by \$175,000.
