Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 130317

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 130317, being a resolution to grant a special privilege to Prince of Peace/Principe de Paz Congregation to construct and maintain an underground conduit in the public right-of-way to provide electrical power to light poles located at 1007-29 South 24th Street from the main church property located at 1114 South 25th Street.

The applicant constructed a new parking at 1007-29 South 24th Street. In order to provide electric power for lighting the parking lot, the applicant is requesting permission to construct and maintain an underground conduit in the north-south alley in the block bounded by West Mineral Street, West Scott Street, South 24th Street and South 25th Street.

We are not aware that the presence of said underground conduit will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow said conduit to occupy the public right-of-way.
