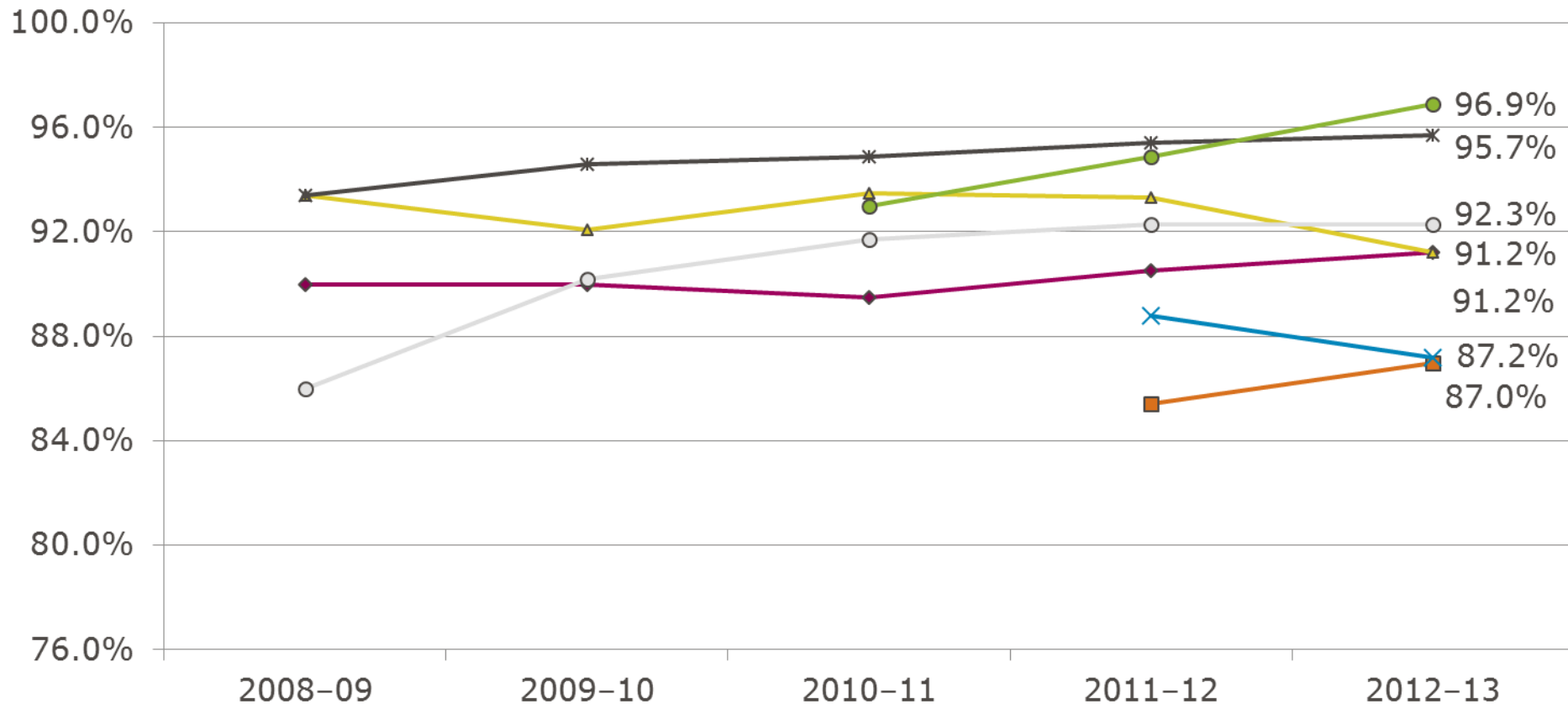

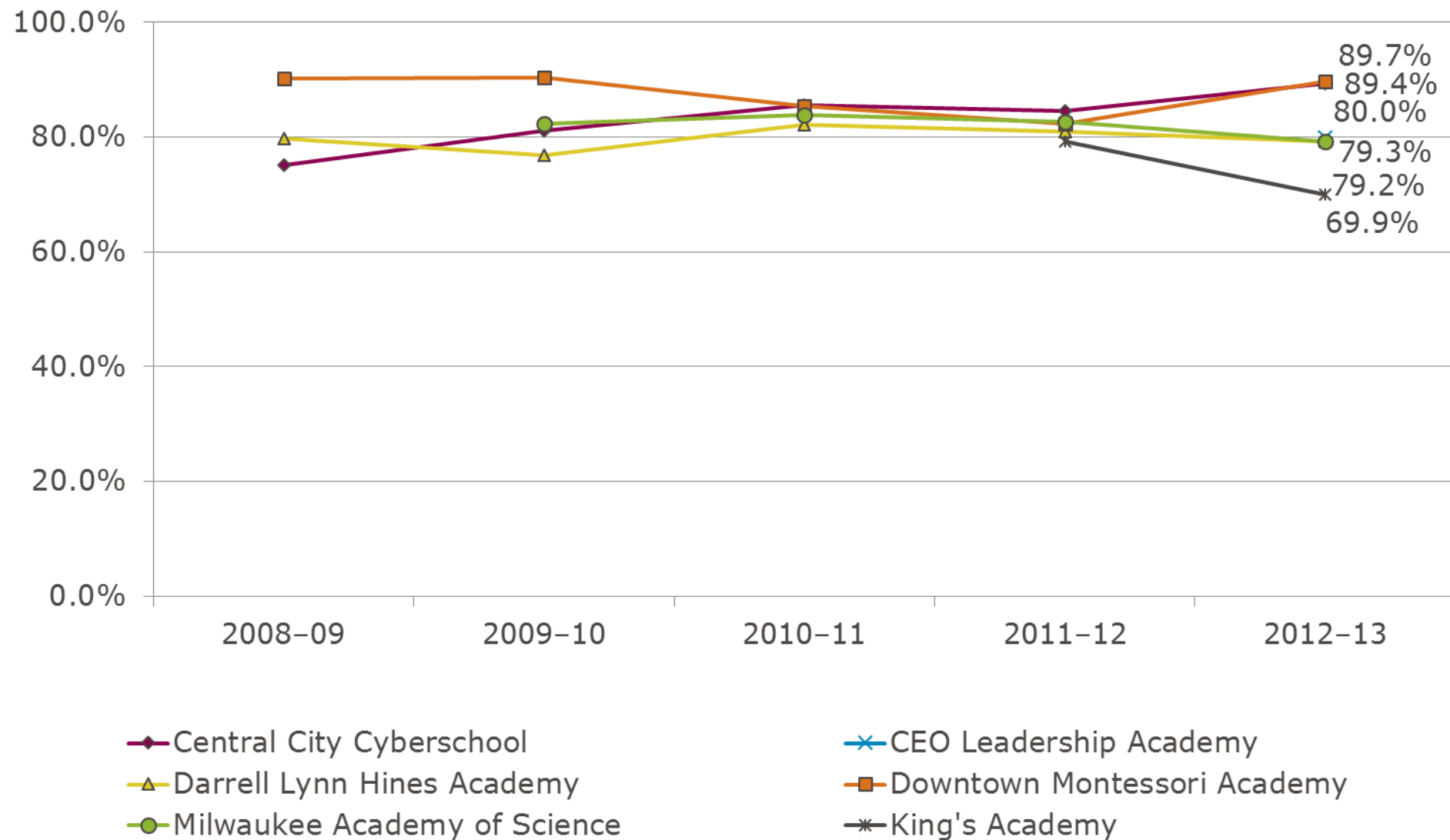

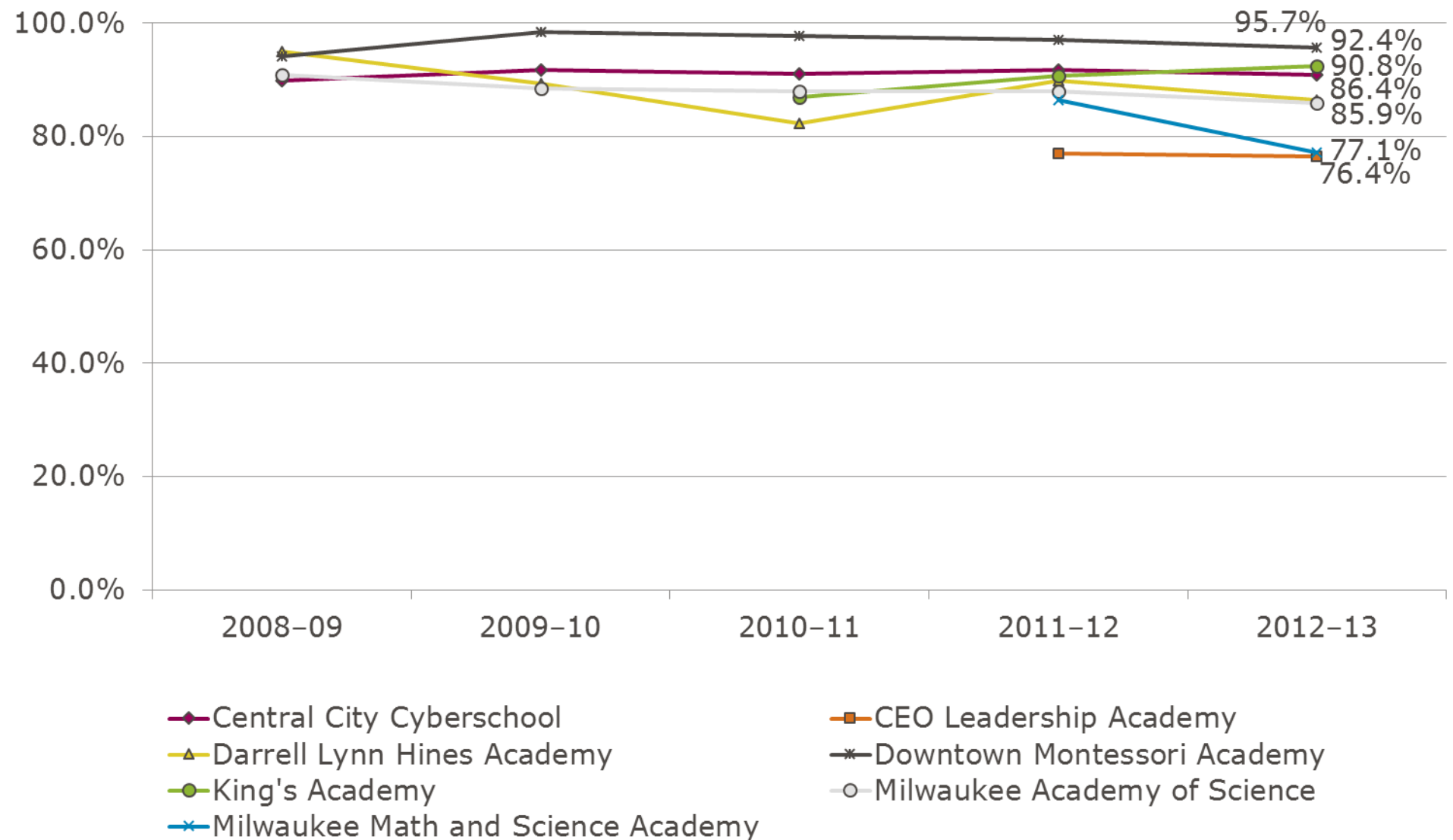


# Student Return Rates

# Student Retention Rates: Percentage Enrolled the Entire School Year

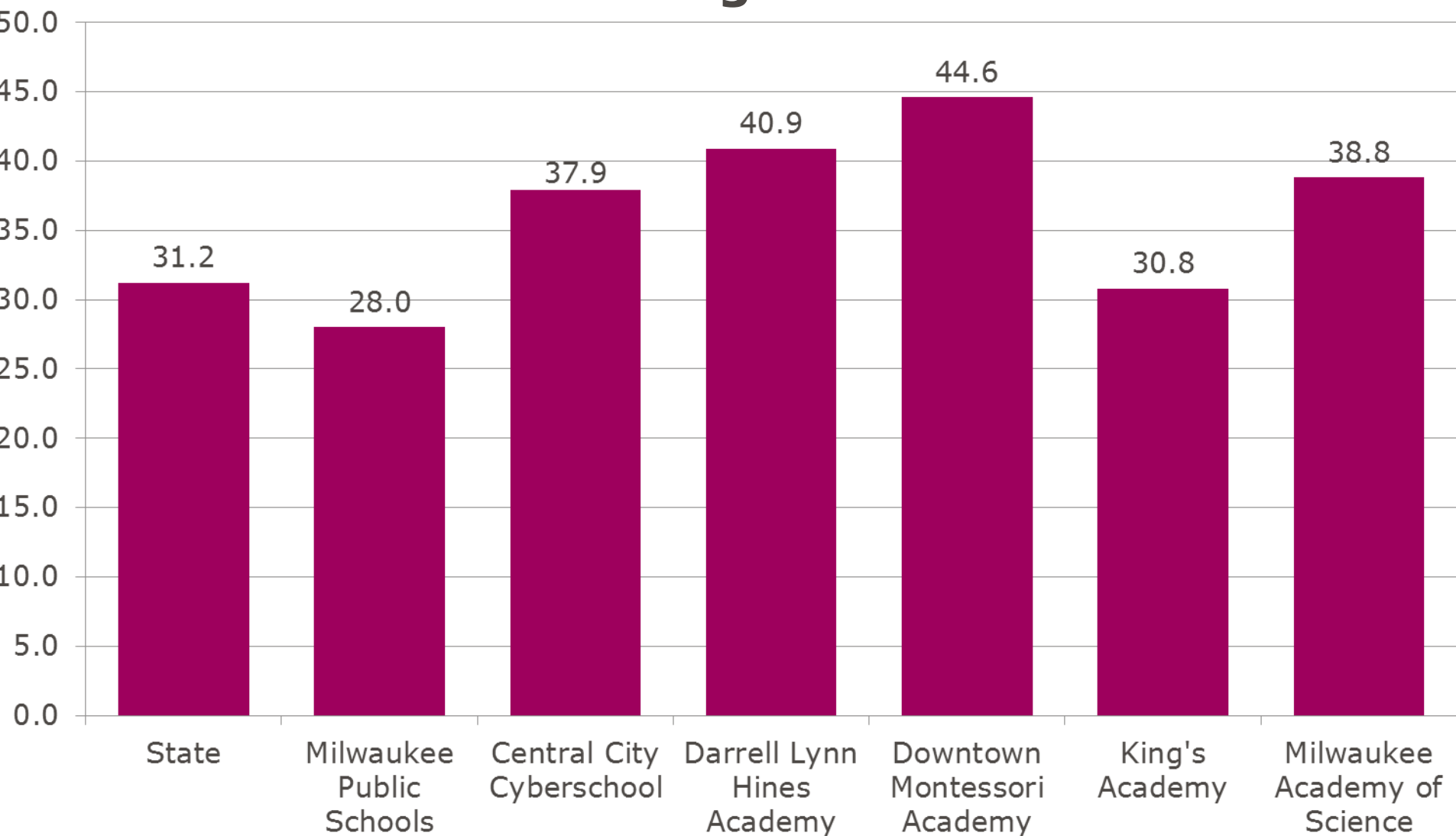

### Student Reading Growth Scores

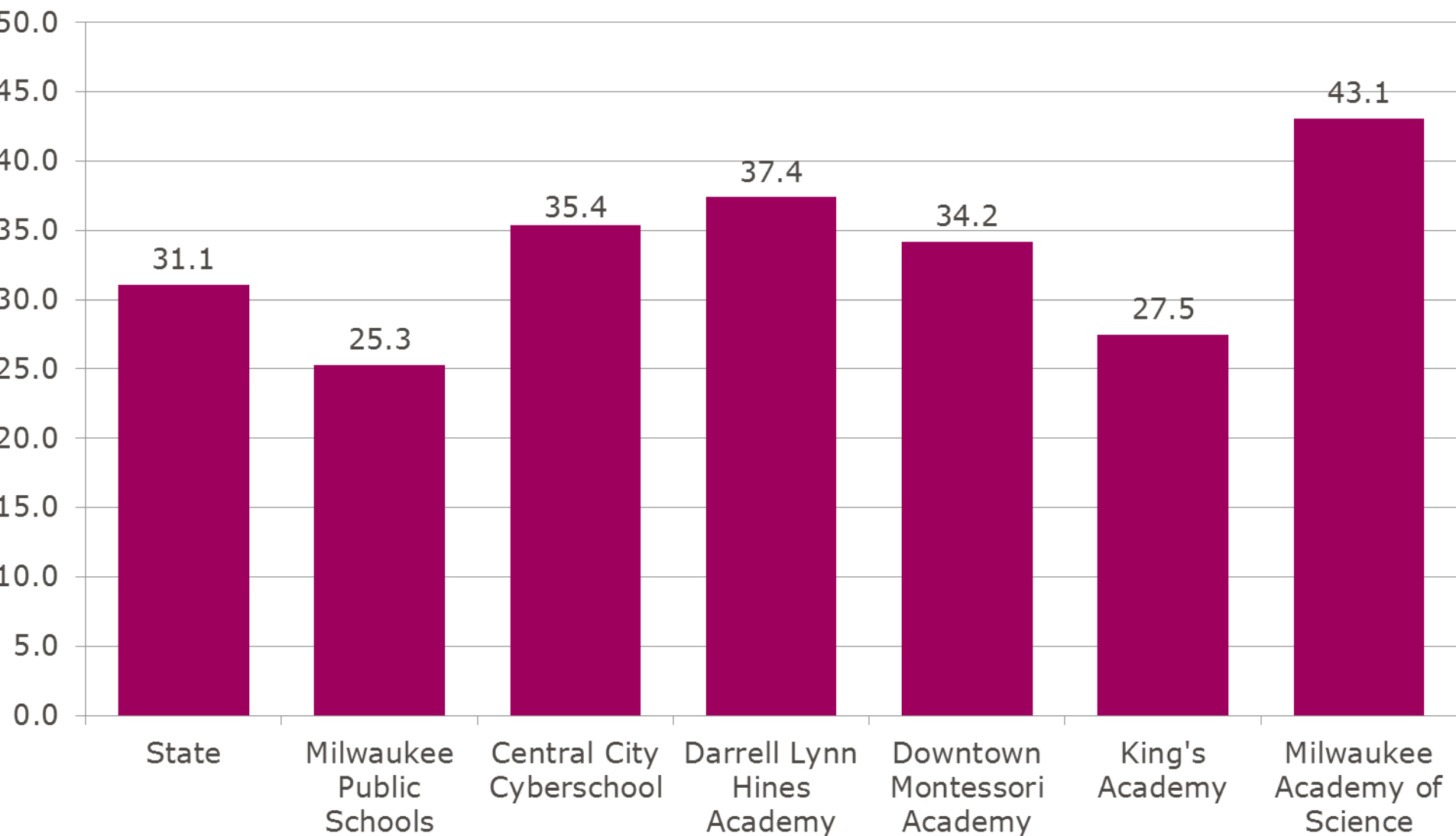
