Inclusion of Proposed Executive Budget revenues as recognized revenues	Occurs at Comptroller's discretion. Typically, revenue increases associated with policy changes are not recognized until Common Council action. However, in some cases recognition has occurred prior to Common Council action.	Must be included as part of the Proposed Executive Budget. As under current law, recognition would only apply to revenues for which the City has statutory authority.
Responsibility for estimating revenues	Comptroller	No Change, remains the authority of the Comptroller.
Authority to adopt all budgeted revenues, including Municipal Service Charges	Common Council	No Change, remains the authority of the Common Council.
