All wood must be pianted upoin completion. Please note that research has shown that new bare wood is left exposed to the exterior elements for a period of only a week or two the life the paint job subsequently applied to it will be decreased. Glas must clear. No low-e or tinted.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 


Figure 1. Remove vinyl windows on first floor and replace with new all wood windows to match the existing. Glass must be clear. No Low-e or tinted.
