Fire Dispatch Receives The 911 Call

Calls come into the MFD Dispatch Center 24hrs a day, seven days a week.



The Call is Triaged

- Priority Dispatch software is used to triage the call and give the caller directions.
 - For example: How to do CPR or stop bleeding while awaiting EMS.
- The call is triaged into one of three basic levels:
 - ALS (Advanced Life Support),
 - high level BLS (Basic Life Support) or
 - low level BLS



The closest Fire Paramedic Unit(s) is dispatched.
 The closest fire apparatus is dispatched.



Higher Level BLS

Fire apparatus is sent alone & the patient is further triaged.

•A private BLS ambulance is called to transport or
•A fire paramedic (ALS unit) is called.



Lower level BLS:

•MFD dispatchers send the call directly to the individual private ambulance dispatch computer.

Each individual ambulance company then dispatches their BLS ambulances
