Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 120066, being a resolution to amend a special privilege for change of ownership to AIM Investments LLC and for addition of a concrete platform for the premises at 728 East Brady Street.

In 2000, the Common Council granted permission to AMB Enterprises Incorporated to install and maintain a covered walk and moveable planters in the public right-of-way. The present owner, AIM Investments LLC, is now requesting permission to construct and maintain a concrete platform projecting into the west, 16-foot wide sidewalk area of North Cass Street. A site visit also revealed the presence of three new concrete filled metal bollards in the public way adjacent to the building.

We are not aware that the presence of said items have had or will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will formally allow said items to occupy the public right-of-way and will change the name of the property owner.
