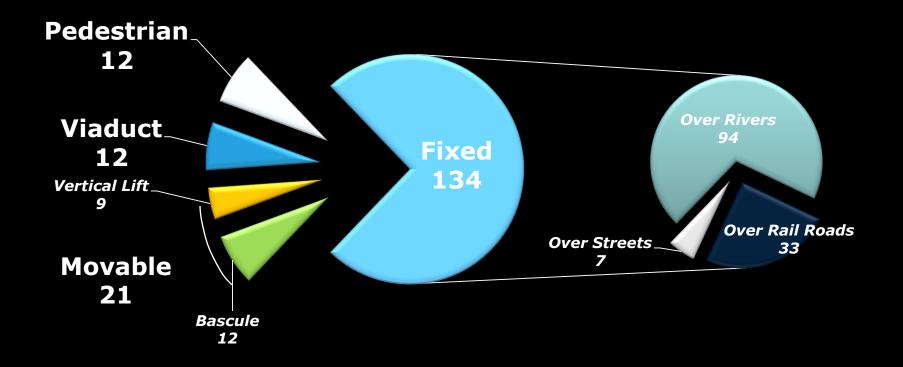

Bridge State & Federal Program

- Available for bridges deemed as federally eligible
- Competitive application process for limited WisDOT state-wide Bridge Program dollars
- Application on 3 year cycle through County government
- Usual 80% Federal/State funded with 20% local share

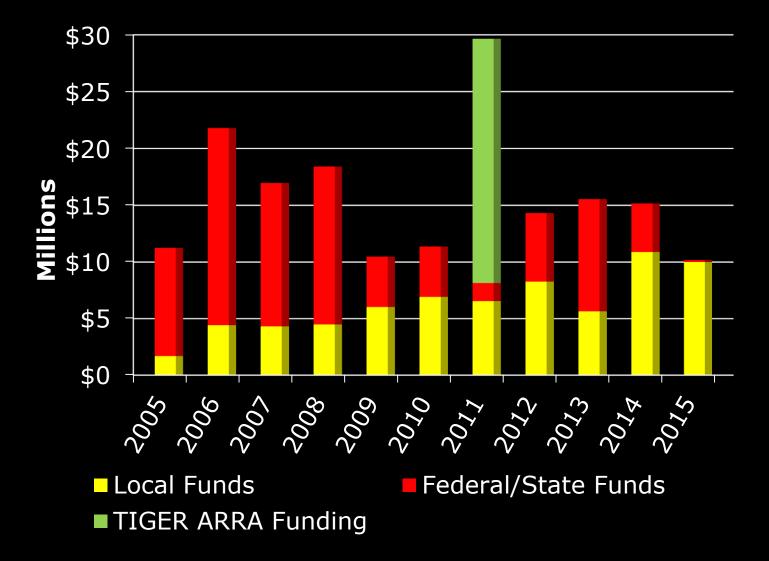
Bridge Local Program

- Bridges not deemed Federal/State eligible
- Bridges in which Federal/State funds not available or insufficient
- Maintenance work including structure repair, painting, mechanical upgrades, inspections, pre-engineering activities, etc.
- Bridge Safety inspections
