

Dear City Clerk Owczarski:

I represented Horacio Sanchez d/b/a El Rodeo before the Licenses Committee. My client objects to the revocation of his liquor license for numerous reasons. On behalf of my client, I will be requesting to present an oral argument to the full Milwaukee Common Council on Tuesday, April 22, 2014 at 9:00 a.m.

Regarding the alleged findings of fact, my client objects to Item A being used as a basis for the license revocation. The shooting did not occur in El Rodeo nor was it connected to the operation of the business. In fact, the shooting occurred somewhere outside the business location and the suspect came from a different tavern.

Regarding Item C, my client inadvertently thought it was daylight savings time.

Regarding Item D and thereafter, there were no exotic dancers or drug trafficking at the licensed premises. Testimony was presented by a female customer that she placed a small amount of cocaine in a coat pocket. She was unaware that the coat belonged to my client. Mr. Sanchez did not admit to possessing the cocaine and he is contesting the charges in court. Mr. Sanchez has not been found guilty of any violations regarding this incident in a court of law. Additionally, Mr. Sanchez is contesting the allegations that he violated the terms and conditions of his liquor license in Milwaukee Municipal Court.

Finally, Mr. Sanchez has been in business for a substantial number of years. There was no testimony about any suspensions or adverse actions taken against him regarding the licensed premises, namely, El Rodeo. With such scant evidence, there is no justification for a revocation of my client's liquor license.
