- 2013-14 MPS enrollment up 2% over projections
- 15 MPS charter schools; 40% increase since 2010
- Building capacity for 105,333 students
- 2013-14 enrollment, 78,502 students
- Working from District Long Range Facility Master Plan (2011)





MPS School Expansion Theory of Action

- Create schools that are visionary incubators of fresh ideas
- Replicate successful programs
- Establish models to turnaround low-performing schools



^{*}Facility condition index is a widely used indicator that provides a relative scale of the overall condition of a given facility. The index is derived by dividing the total repair costs, including educational adequacy and site-related repairs by the total replacement costs. An FCI of 21% or higher is considered below average condition. The district average FCI is 29%.


