Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 131755, being an amendment to a special privilege for change of ownership to R & R Holdings LLC for entrance steps, planter boxes, and shelf with planter in the public right-of-way for the premises at 1301-1307 East Brady Street.

Mimma's Café Incorporated requested permission to keep and maintain five sets of entrance steps, several excess door swings, several moveable planters, three stationary planters, and a utility piping enclosure in the public right-of-way. Permission for said items was originally granted in 1995 and subsequently in 2008 under Common Council Resolution File Number 080119. The excess door swings are now permitted and the moveable planters have been removed from the public right-of-way.

We are not aware that the presence of said items has had or will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will amend the ownership of the above special privilege and will formally allow said items to continue to occupy the public right-of-way.
