On April 8, 2014, I received a letter from the Office of the City Attorney; stating that the City of Milwaukee would not be held liable for the damages that incurred to my property when two bullets fired from Milwaukee Police Department Officers' guns came shattering through my bedroom window on November 30, 2013; as they (The Milwaukee Police Department) attempted to subdue a suspect who resisted being taken into custody.

r do understand that "accidents" are things that we do not intend to happen, but when they do occur, someone or something is usually liable and responsible for the accident. Although the Milwaukee Police Department Officers did not intend to damage my windows, I am having a hard time understanding why the City of Milwaukee will not accept responsibility for the "accident" that did occur; and compensate me for the damages that incurred as a result of the incident. My husband and I are retired, and we are living on a fixed-income.
