Subject:	Revisions to Estimates of Costs to Implement a City Minimum Wage		

You had requested information about the potential costs to the City were it to implement a minimum wage requirement much like Milwaukee County has done recently.

I originally provided information to you that, after further analysis, underestimated the potential costs related to service contracts with salary wages of \$11.47 and \$12.61 (100% and 110% of poverty). This, in turn, resulted in changes upward for the potential costs overall.

The following table provides the revised numbers and presents them in a range. The higher number in the range is based on all reported cases in the data collected by the City on service contacts under s. 310-13-7 of the Code. The lower number reflects the exclusion of some cases due to the fact that the data is erroneous and is therefore best left out of the analysis.
