
All work will be done according to the drawings and specifications included in this COA. Bottom of pickets must be no more than 3 inches above grade. Fence must be painted upon completion.

Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
