In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

Venting for new furnace must be on either the rear elevation (north side of building) or as far to the rear as possible on the west side of the building. Venting must not face 24th Street or W. St. Paul Avenue. Central a/c unit must be set on grade next to the foundation at the rear of the building on the north elevation. Units must not be on the front or either of the two long sides of the building.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
