Michelle St.) (ST211140111) File Number 120112: Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches as necessary, sodding (11-foot width of tree border area), and grading. (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$22,400; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$175,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$220,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2014 construction season.
W. Helena St. - N. 86th St. to N. 90th Blvd. (including W. Helena Ct.) (ST211140118) File Number 140037: Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches as necessary, sodding (14-foot width of tree border area), and grading. (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$11,200; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund --

Sherman Blvd. (ST212140120) File Number 120369: Concrete alley pavement reconstruction, replace some abutting walk or driveway approaches, grading, storm drainage facilities, and permeable pavement as necessary. (Assessable Alley Paving Fund -- \$22,800; Nonassessable Alley Paving Fund -- \$70,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$92,800. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2014 construction season.

Commissioner of Public Works is authorized and directed to proceed with said work in accordance with said report pursuant to Section 66.0703 and any other pertinent sections of the Wisconsin Statutes and in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it Further Resolved, That the proper departments take such action as is required of them to assess the abutting or adjacent properties and collect such assessment in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be it Further Resolved, That the projects do not involve any parcels of agricultural land which are eligible for deferred special assessments under the provisions of Section 14.30 of the Milwaukee City Charter, and, be it Further Resolved, That the Department of Public Works is authorized to use the funding as specified in the above description of work; and, be it Further Resolved, That projects: W. Helena St. (ST211140118), Alley W. Center St. (ST212140125), and Alley W. Clarke St. (ST212140125) will be billed after January 1, 2016, but not before 12 months after the project contract has been completed; and, be it Further Resolved, That project: W. Beatrice St. (ST211140111) will be billed after January 1, 2017, but not before 12 months after the project contract has been completed.
