- Exterior Windows
- Chimney
- Front Balusters

The plan for this phase of our renovation is to continue our fund raising efforts to pay for the labor and material. Our projected costs (after gifted material and labor) will be approximately \$15 thousand dollars. We anticipate that this project will take two years from start to finish; therefore we are requesting a two year extension to complete this phase of our demolition.

Windows

There are various windows that need to be repaired and/or replaced. We plan to paint and repair the windows that are able to be repaired and replace those that can not. Because it is our intention to maintain the integrity of the building, we will seek to obtain approval from the Historic Preservation Commission before purchasing any material .

Chimney


The chimney needs a complete demolition. It must be capped off ,and all surrounding material must be replaced. Some of the labor will be gifted to us, however much of the material will not. Again, all materials will be approved by the HPC.

Front Balusters:

There are ten balusters that need to be replaced in the front of the building. This job is a bit more challenging. This part of the project will take great attention to detail and must be completed by an extremely skilled mason. Again, Love Tabernacle Church will ensure it seeks approval from the HPC for this phase of the project as well.
