A public hearing has been scheduled for Monday, September 8, 2014 at 3:00 p.m. in City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Room 301-B to determine whether or not the proposed designations satisfy the criteria for historic designation in accordance with Section 320-21 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

Following Commission action on this matter, a recommendation regarding the nominations shall be forwarded to the Milwaukee Common Council.
