Dear Mr. Matson,

This letter reports the in rem residential rent collections and corresponding in rem property related expenditures by the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee (RACM). As you are aware, the Authority invoices and collects rent on occupied city properties taken in through tax foreclosure. Rent proceeds supplement City resources appropriated to the Department of City Development to cover the costs of managing and marketing in rem property.

From 2009 through 2013, RACM collected \$2,257,006.12 in residential rent and expended \$2,239,737.06 on in rem property maintenance and repairs. The net difference of the rent collections and expenditures is \$17,269.06. Attributing to this

Net Revenue expenses and the shortfall of \$193,891.56 was covered by RACM general reserves.

17,269.06 difference is the significant negative balance in 2010, when rent revenue fell short of The Authority is requesting that the \$17,269.06 net revenue from 2009 through 2013 be retained to continue our property maintenance obligations. The city currently has over 1,200 in rem properties in its possession and expects to add another 700-800 properties through 2014 foreclosure actions. If it is your preference that the Authority should make a payment to the city for the net revenue balance, please inform our staff at your convenience.
