

AN AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SISTER CITIES RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE (U.S.A.) AND THE CITY OF MEDAN (INDONESIA)

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee, The United States of America, and the City of Medan, The Republic of Indonesia, have achieved the following agreement through friendly negotiation, and herewith express intention to promote the friendship and understanding between the peoples of City of Milwaukee and City of Medan; and

Whereas, in order to foster those goals, the people of Milwaukee and Medan in a gesture of friendship and goodwill, agree to collaborate for the mutual benefit of their communities by exploring educational, economic and cultural opportunities; and

Whereas, we agree to support and encourage opportunities for mutually beneficial practical exchanges in the fields of business, culture, health care, education, science and technology, and tourism; and

Whereas, Milwaukee and Medan, sharing a common interest in education, health care and business, and the desire to promote mutual understanding among our citizens do hereby proclaim themselves Sister Cities beginning on May 13, 2014, the date of Milwaukee Common Council resolution establishing the Sister City relationship became effective;

Now Therefore, Milwaukee and Medan do hereby proclaim themselves Sister Cities.
