Venting must be on the rear of the house or on a side elevation that is not visible from the street. ALL VENT PIPES MUST BE PAINTED OUT TO BLEND WITH THE COLOR OF THE SURROUNDING BUILDING MATERIALS.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
