


In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

All work will be done according to the drawings, photographs and specifications contained in this COA. The new sign will match exactly the size, colors and overall design of the existing sign above the entry doors. ALL CONNECTIONS TO THE BUILDING MUST BE THROUGH THE MORTAR JOINTS AND NOT THROUGH THE FACES OF THE BRICK. Please note that approval of a second story sign on this part of the building does not necessarily consisted approval of second story signage elsewhere on the building.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
