Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 140599, being a resolution to grant a special privilege to Milwaukee Treasures LLC to construct and maintain an underground conduit, fence, hand railings, retaining wall and concrete curbs in the public right-of-way for the premises at 3333 West Highland Boulevard.

The applicant is converting an existing house into a health center and police substation. As part of the project the applicant is requesting permission to construct and maintain underground communications conduits crossing North 33rd Street to connect 3333 West Highland Boulevard and 3234 West State Street. A site visit revealed the presence of a decorative metal fence, hand railings, retaining wall and concrete curbs in the public right-of-way. All of these above ground items are located behind the main public sidewalks of either West Highland Boulevard or North 33rd Street and do not interfere with pedestrian traffic.

We are not aware that the presence of said items will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow said items to occupy the public right-of-way.
