
2014 TRAFFIC FATALITIES

2014 Crash Data

Total crashes

slightly above the 8-year average

Crash severity

- Incapacitating injury crashes slightly below the 8-year average
- Increase in total number of occupants involved in crashes

- Prosecutions 23
 - o 70 felony charges / 16 misdemeanor
