File # 010841 is a resolution relative to the acceptance and funding of a *Supplemental* Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant (JAIBG) by the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD).

### Background

JAIBG is a federal program that was created by the U.S. Congress in 1998 to promote greater accountability in the juvenile justice system. Funding is provided to improve policies, programs and administrative systems that foster the creation of safe communities and reduce the incidence and negative consequences of juvenile crime and delinquency.

JAIBG is a continuing program.

Common Council File # 981631 granted MPD the original authority to apply for funds under this block grant program.

#### **Discussion**

This resolution authorizes application, acceptance and expenditure of a Supplemental Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant from the State of Wisconsin, Department of Justice, Office of Justice Assistance.

Funds proved for this grant are discretionary dollars that are disbursed on a one-time basis.

These grant monies will fund a bicycle trailer for the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Milwaukee.

- 4. This trailer is to be used for a joint community service program involving the distribution and repair of bicycles for disadvantaged youth.
- 5. This is a supplemental grant to encompass the period from July 1, 2001 through September 30, 2001.

## Fiscal Impact

The total funding of this grant is **\$6,139** of which \$2099 is provided by the Boys and Girls Club and \$4,040 is provided by the grantor.

2. There is **no** fiscal impact to the city.
