File # 001475 is a resolution appropriating funds from the 2001 Special Purpose Account-Reimbursable Services Advance Fund.

Background

- 1. The Reimbursable Services Advance Fund advances funds to city departments to pay for services and materials which will subsequently be reimbursed through non-tax levy funding sources.
- 2. Funds must be appropriated by Common Council resolution in accord with Common Council File 80-1513.

Discussion

- 1. The Hepatitis A program, conducted by the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD), is in need of \$20,000 to cover increased reimbursable expenses.
- 2. MHD provides Hepatitis A vaccine and testing for city employees in the police, fire and health departments, the Departments of Public Works and Community Development and other employees as needed or requested.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The fiscal impact to the city is \$20,000.
- 2. This money will be reimbursed to the city upon receipt of payment for services related to the Hepatitis A program.
