- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department to accept and fund a Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Grant project from the Centers for Disease Control through the State of Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services.
- 2. This is a continuing grant resolution.

#### **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of this grant project is to support comprehensive and coordinated service delivery to lead-poisoned children and their families.
- 2. Services funded through this grant include:
  - Screening
  - Laboratory analysis
  - Nursing case management
  - Environmental inspections
  - Community health education
  - Program management
- 3. This grant encompasses the period of July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003.

### Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total of this grant is \$535,000, entirely from the grantor.
