File # 020164 is a resolution relative to acceptance and funding of the Fight Asthma Milwaukee Allies Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to accept and fund the Fight Asthma Milwaukee Allies Grant project from Children's Hospital of Wisconsin (CHW).
- 2. This is a new grant.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of this project will be to support care coordination and case management for children who receive emergency department services due to the severity of their asthma.
- 2. The monitoring of, and assurance of care for pediatric asthma cases is a strategic priority for MHD's Home Environmental Health and Maternal and Child Health Divisions.
- 3. This subcontract will allow MHD to develop the service infrastructure needed to serve families impacted by asthma through care coordination and case management.
- 4. This grant project intends to work toward the reduction of hospitalizations and emergency room visits relative to pediatric asthma.
- 5. MHD staff will identify families eligible for these services and measure the effectiveness of these services through pre/post surveys regarding parent and children quality of life relative to care coordination and case management. The care coordinator will monitor data and provide care coordination on a citywide basis working with CHW and various HMO providers.
- 6. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002.

Fiscal Impact

1. The total amount of this grant is \$66,826, entirely from the grantor.

- 2. This grant (94%) will fund the following MHD positions with salary and fringe benefits:
 - 1 *new* Care Coordinator, SG 03 or 04 (This position has not yet been classified)
 - 1 existing Office Assistant II (0.2 FTE), SG 410
- 3. CHW has assured funding for this project for three years.
