The Health Department is submitting the following grant application resolutions for Common Council approval:

<u>Asthma Demonstration Grant</u> - This is new funding from the United States Environmental Protection Agency. This community based in-home asthma environmental education and management grant will support public health nurse case managers who will visually assess environmental asthma triggers in the home environment and provide education and support to families to remediate existing allergens.

<u>Healthy Homes Demonstration Project</u> - This new funding from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development will serve 75 families who have children with moderate to severe asthma. Families will receive home environmental assessment for asthma triggers and home interventions to reduce asthma triggers such as dust mites, cockroach infestations, and mold.

<u>HUD Lead Abatement Extension Grant</u> - This is funding for the Health Department from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development to extend the current work of the Lead Abatement Grant. These monies will fund lead hazard reduction in 800 low-income housing units located in the Lead Program's target area.
