File # 020408 is a resolution relative to the application for the Asthma Demonstration Project.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to apply for the Asthma Demonstration Grant Project from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
- 2. This resolution is for *application only*. MHD will submit another resolution for acceptance and expenditure if awarded this grant funding.

Discussion

- 1. This community-based project will fund public health case managers who will assess in-home environmental triggers and provide education and support to families for the purpose of the remediation of asthma allergens.
- 2. This project will be a component of a comprehensive asthma initiative led by Children's Hospital of Wisconsin-Fight Asthma Milwaukee Allies.
- 3. The reduction of asthma-related hospitalizations for children less than 17 years of age is a program result measure for the MHD Home Environmental Health Division.
- 4. The anticipated grant period is January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2005.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. MHD is applying for \$150,000 from the EPA.
- 2. There is no fiscal impact at this time. A budget for this project will be developed in the event, and at the time, that MHD receives grant dollars for this project.
